DECILE RATING

Unfortunately we did not receive the required survey forms back from our parent community for the Ministry of Education to review our Decile Rating. As previously outlined, we were hoping to get our decile 8 rating changed to a 7 from this review. Schools from deciles 1-7 will be receiving \$150 per child in 2020 to alleviate costs to parents. Next year we will need to continue asking parents for school donations to cover any shortfalls in funding from the Ministry of Education. However, the MOE will be abolishing the decile-based school funding system by 2021-2022. We await with interest as to any proposed systems to replace this present decile system.
