



## Tena koutou katoa – Greetings to you all

We welcomed our students back from the school holidays at an assembly on Monday. Here we discussed some expectations around our school POWER Values, especially the value of respect and what that looks like. Teachers have also been delivering the same messages to their students this week to set the standards for this term. They will be sending home a class newsletter outlining their term overview.

Families, please continue to keep in touch with your child's teacher if you have any concerns. All Mid-Term Reports were sent home yesterday.

### **10 YEAR PROPERTY PLAN (10YPP)**

Schools are required to develop 10 Year Property Plans (10YPPs) to ensure that their school is well maintained and the physical environment supports teaching and learning, within the budgets provided by the Ministry. The 10YPP sets out the property work to be completed over a 10 year timeframe.

Kio Kio School used Matt Whitmarsh from Whitmarsh Architects as our property consultant. Matt carried out a condition assessment of our school and liaised with our Board of Trustees to develop our plan which covers the next 5 years. Some projects are:

- Replace old fluorescent lights with LED lights
- Replace carpet and wall linings in our library
- Fit underfloor insulation to all floor areas
- Replace heat pumps when required
- Addition of a 3 metre deck and verandah roof to north side (main teaching block) to form an outdoor teaching area
- Fit stacker doors to classrooms leading out onto this deck

Matt will also be our Project Manager for the projects set out in the plan.

You are most welcome to view the Property Plan, which is held in our school office. Please check with Rachel, our office administrator.

### **ARTIFICIAL TURFING**

Another project is the artificial turfing of our existing asphalt courts. The Ministry of Education has provided a portion of the funds for this project (\$15000) and our wonderful Supporter's Committee with \$10000. There is a shortfall which

our BOT is endeavouring to make up. Emma Telfer, a board member is applying to a number of funding organisations seeking their support for this project. This requires a lot of hours in research and applying for these funds. Thanks heaps Emma.

The courts, when completed, will have 2 netball and tennis courts and a hockey practice/playing facility, but will also be used for a range of other physical education activities.

### **BADMINTON CUP**

Rosemary Fleming is once again running the badminton practice sessions for 24 year 7 and 8 students this term. This consists of a 1 hour lunchtime session each week. At the end of the term, Rosemary will run the cup competition where we find out our year 7/8 girl and boy champions for 2020. Thanks so much Rosemary!

### **REC CENTRE HIREAGE**
