### **PRINCIPALS REPORT**

**Teacher only day -** Today, our teachers are attending a teacher only day at St Mary's Catholic School in Otorohanga. We have some Ministry of Education staff delivering PLD (professional learning and development) in the new Mathematics and Literacy curriculum. The main focus is on the progress outcomes for each of these areas. The start date for the new curriculum is at the beginning of 2025.

Teachers will also receive PLD in writing. Cheryl Hickford, DP at Otorohanga South will be leading our learning in a writing method called 'The Writing Revolution'. This provides teachers with an proven and instructional evidence-based methodology to enhance students' learning and achievement in writing across all curriculum areas. Teacher Aides - Our teacher aides will also be receiving PLD today in structured literacy. They will have a session with our local Resource Teacher of Literacy, Liz Roberts, followed by 2 online webinar sessions with Learning Matters. It is extremely important for all staff to be able to understand the components and delivery of structured literacy when working with students.

Our school provides the extra money and resources to have teacher aides supporting teachers and students for a whole school day, in comparison to other schools. Especially so, as we have a range of students with diverse needs.

**Fireworks Gala** - This is our major fundraiser for this year, so please get along and support this wonderful event. Our Supporters' Committee have been gearing up for this event for a few months, so please support them by helping out on the night in some way.

Coming to Kio Kio Community Hall for the 1<sup>st</sup> time SAT 16 DEC 6pm. Join us for a night you won't forget!


6pm Skate Lesson 50min \$10 7pm Roller Disco 90min \$10 Skate hire \$5 or bring your own
